Poble Espanyol

An open-air architectural unique spot

Feel the soul of Spain, admire traditional architecture, buy typical craftsmanship and enjoy local food. All this can be found in “Spanish Village”, the one-of-a-kind space at the foot of Montjuïc Mountain. Visitors can stroll through this complex formed by 117 buildings representing various regions of the country, with cultural and leisure activities in a relaxed atmosphere.

Colònia Güell

Antoni Gaudí's inspiration

This colony is one of the most pioneering purpose-built industrial villages of the 19th century. It is located in Santa Coloma de Cervelló (23 Km from Barcelona). The crypt designed by Gaudí stands out, despite being unfinished. Gaudí introduced important architectural innovations that laid the foundations for what would later become the Sagrada Família.

CosmoCaixa

Science for the entire family

The Barcelona Science Museum exhibitions goal is to bring science in an entertaining way. In this sense, the new permanent exhibition “Universe room” allows us to discover the cosmos and its evolution from the big-bang to the present day.

Sant Pau Recinte Modernista

Domènec i Montaner

“A city within the city”, Sant Pau is the largest Modernist complex in the world and also the most important work of the Modernist architect Lluís Domènec i Montaner. Take a journey through this World Heritage Site -one of the oldest medical institutions in Europe- showing its design, its construction and its evolution.

To celebrate the 25th anniversary in Spain, Cirque du Soleil returns with a revised version of its iconic show Alegría. Tapas and paella
