Balloon Museum

Pop Air, Art is inflatable

The aim of the Ballon Museum is to create art in motion that can be touched and experienced by children and adults alike. The initiative has already received several awards such as Best Original Format at the BEA World Festival 2022 event competition and has been featured in the third season of the Netflix series 'Emily in Paris'. The exhibition will take place at the Victòria Eugènia Palace, built for the 1929 International Exhibition of Barcelona and renovated in 2018.

Candlelight Barcelona

Candelight offers a series of classical music concerts paying tribute to a variety of musical genres and artists such as Queen, Coldplay or Hans Zimmer in the most unique scenarios as the Recinte Modernista de Sant Pau and among thousands of candles: An immersive musical experience.

Colònia Giiell

Antoni Gaudi's inspiration

This colony is one of the most pioneering purpose –built industrial villages of the 19th century. It is located in Santa Coloma de Cervelló (23 Km from Barcelona). The crypt designed by Gaudí stands out, despite being unfinished. Gaudí introduced important architectural innovations that laid the foundations for what would later become the Sagrada Familia.

Laberint d'Horta

A Cultural Asset of Local Interest

Located at the bottom of Collserola mountain (Horta District) this park is the oldest garden (1792) preserved in the city, with neoclassical and romantic gardens, sculptures, ponds, waterfalls and fountains. But above all, it highlights a fantastic cypress tree labyrinth, in which the visitor will find it easy to enter, but perhaps not so easy to leave...
